The first meeting of the "No Name" Englewood Quilting group was held at the Sports Complex in Englewood on November 9, 2004 at 10:00 am. Even though there were many invited to attend unfortunately there were only four in attendance. Those present were Marie Batisk, Lucille Gelineau, Jan Sweetser and Betty McClenathan. Officers were chosen: Betty McClenathan, Pres., Jan Sweetser, V. Pres., Lucille Gelineau, Secretary and Treasurer Mickey Slattery. Board members were chosen: Cathy Neffinger, Betty McClenathan and Marie Batisk. It was decided not to hold any meetings until January. At this time we felt that maybe we would be a little more organized. On this agenda was : Name of the guild, get some information regarding by -laws, rules, etc.
